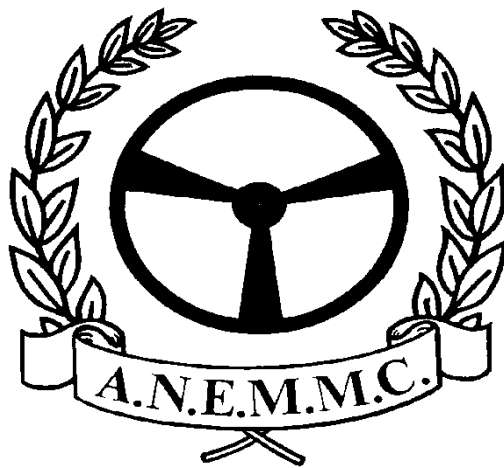

# **Roadrunner Phoenix Awards Stage Rally Championship 2012**

(supported by Pantry Catering and Slick Tyres)

## **Organisers Regulations (both Multi-Use & Multi-Venue Championships)**

- 1) All fully paid up affiliated Motor clubs within the ANEMMC may submit events for inclusion within this championship. All events must be National B events.
  - 2) All events will be run to the General Competition Rules of the MSA and must be open to all member clubs of the ANEMMC or registered contenders of The Roadrunner Phoenix Awards ANEMMC stage rally championship.
  - 3) The Association Levy will be payable upon acceptance into the championship and is to be sent to the Association treasurer no later than 31st January in the year of the championship. Should an event fail to run, the levy will be refunded in full to the respective Motor Club.
  - 4) The MSA permit number TBA has been issued for the championship. A copy of this Permit will be forwarded to all event organisers of the Roadrunner Phoenix Awards ANEMMC stage rally championship rounds; please ensure that the Permit Number is published within the event Supplementary Regulations and is displayed on the Official Notice Board throughout the running of the event.
  - 5) Organisers are to ensure that they keep the administrator fully consulted at all times with regard to any date changes, problems with the event or other such details.
  - 6) Regulations must clearly state that the event is a Round of the Roadrunner Phoenix Awards ANEMMC stage rally championship and carry a full-page advertisement of the championship sponsors. This artwork will be provided by the Administrator.
  - 7) Organisers are to ensure that a set of regulations are forwarded to the administrator at the time of publication and further paperwork such as final instructions and a full entry list [including individuals clubs, type and CC size of car and class entered] are sent to the administrator
  - 8) Organisers must send event regulations to all registered contenders the administrator will provide labels for this purpose.
  - 9) A final set of results must be sent to the coordinator within 7 days of the results being declared final together with any amended entry list.
  - 10) Failure to comply with the above may result in the event not being selected for the championship the following year.
  - 11) Event organisers must ensure that sufficient space is made available at signing on for the championship administrator and or the championship tables to be displayed.
  - 12) Event organisers must ensure that all contender registration cards are shown at signing on.
  - 13) Promotional material may be passed to the coordinator for publication within the Association championship bulletin.
  - 14) The Championship shall consist of:
    - a) Class 0 – up to 1000cc
    - b) Class 1 – 1001cc to 1400cc
    - c) Class 2 - 1401cc to 1600cc
    - d) Class 3 - 1601cc to 2000cc
    - e) Class 4 - over 2000cc
    - f) Class 5 - All 4 Wheel drive cars only
- Historic Classes shall consist of:
- g) Class 1 - up to 1600cc
  - h) Class 2 - over 1600cc to 2000cc
  - i) Class 3 - over 2000cc

15) Vehicles with Rotary or forced induction will have their engine capacity increased by 70% to determine their class eligibility in accordance with MSA regulations

# **Roadrunner Phoenix Awards Multi-Use Stage Rally Championship 2012** (supported by Pantry Catering and Slick Tyres)

## **Competitors Regulations**

- 1) The Championship will be known as “The ROADRUNNER PHOENIX AWARDS ANEMMC Multi-use Stage Rally Championship 2012”
- 2) Events to be included in the championship have been selected from events nominated by member clubs and approved at an Association meeting. These events have been observed and approved for inclusion in the Championship.
- 3) All Drivers and Co-drivers must be fully paid up, valid membership card holding members of an ANEMMC registered club and have registered for the championship. Registration must have been made and accepted before any event for which points can be scored.
- 4) The Championship will be divided into 6 classes as follows:
  - a) Class 0 – up to 1000cc
  - b) Class 1 – 1001cc to 1400cc
  - c) Class 2 - 1401cc to 1600cc
  - d) Class 3 - 1601cc to 2000cc
  - e) Class 4 - 2001cc and over
  - f) Class 5 - All 4 Wheel drive cars only
- 5) Vehicles with Rotary or forced induction will have their engine capacity increased by 70% to determine their class eligibility in accordance with MSA regulations.
- 6) Points will be awarded in the Championship with reference to class positions in the official results and relative to his/her performance against other registered contenders. Points can only be awarded to contenders on National B Stage Rallies where an event may be a round of a National series.
- 7) Points will be awarded as follows:
  - a) 1st in class 50 points
  - b) 2nd in class 48 points
  - c) 3rd in class 46 points
  - d) 4th in class 44 points
  - e) 5th in class 42 points etc.
- 8) A retirement on an event will be awarded 6 points.
- 9) Where there is only one (1) championship competitor entered in a class, a handicap will apply of minus 3 points per event finished.
- 10) The Championship will be 13 rounds in total, with best 8 scores to count for the overall championship.
- 11) In the event of any events not running the following will apply;
  - a) 13 rounds 8 to score
  - b) 12 rounds 8 to score
  - c) 11 rounds 7 to score
  - d) 10 rounds 7 to score
  - e) 9 rounds 7 to score
  - f) 8 rounds 6 to score
  - g) 7 rounds 5 to score
  - h) 6 rounds 5 to score
  - i) 5 rounds or less all to count
- 12) Awards for the overall championship will be as follows:
  - a) 1st/2nd/3rd Overall Driver/Co-Driver
  - b) 1st/2nd/3rd in each Class Driver/Co-Driver (depending on no. of entries)
  - c) Highest Placed Lady Driver

- d) Highest Placed Lady Co-Driver
- e) Under 25 Driver or Co-Driver (must make known at time of registration)

- 13) To receive an award a competitor must have scored a finish.
- 14) No competitor may win more than one award other than a Ladies award, Under 25 in the Championship. In the event of a tie, the competitor scoring the highest number of first places taken the higher placing; then scoring the highest number of second places and so on until the tie is resolved. In the event of a double tie we will take highest score on the first event competed on.
- 15) It is the competitor's responsibility to obtain event regulations.
- 16) Acceptance of all entries will be at each organisers discretion and ANEMMC cannot be held responsible for any refusal of entries.
- 17) Entrants must indicate their Association registration number on their event entry forms.
- 18) Once a competitor has paid their registration fee and returned the registration form points shall automatically be collated from events results without further signing-on at each event. Registration cards may be required at signing-on at the discretion of each individual event organisers.
- 19) It is not necessary for Drivers and Co-drivers to be in the same crew for all events, during the year, as results will be kept for each category.
- 20) Registered contenders will be supplied with two Championship decals, which must be displayed on the competing car at all events.

## Competitors Regulations

1. The Championship will be known as “The ROADRUNNER PHOENIX AWARDS ANEMMC Multi-venue Stage Rally Championship 2012”
2. Events to be included in the championship have been selected from events nominated by member clubs and approved at an Association meeting. These events have been observed and approved for inclusion in the Championship.
3. All Drivers and Co-drivers must be fully paid up, valid membership card holding members of an ANEMMC registered club and have registered for the championship. Registration must have been made and accepted before any event for which points can be scored.
4. The Championship will be divided into 9 classes as follows:
  - a. Class 0 – up to 1000cc
  - b. Class 1 – 1001cc to 1400cc
  - c. Class 2 - 1401cc to 1600cc
  - d. Class 3 - 1601cc to 2000cc
  - e. Class 4 - 2001cc and over
  - f. Class 5 - All 4 Wheel drive cars only
  - g. Historic H6 – Cars up to 1600cc
  - h. Historic H7 – Cars 1601cc to 2000cc
  - i. Historic H8 – Cars 2001cc and over
5. Vehicles with Rotary or forced induction will have their engine capacity increased by 70% to determine their class eligibility in accordance with MSA regulations.
6. Points will be awarded in the Championship with reference to class positions in the official results and relative to his/her performance against other registered contenders. Points can only be awarded to contenders on National B Stage Rallies.
7. Points will be awarded as follows:
  - a. 1st in class 50 points
  - b. 2nd in class 48 points
  - c. 3rd in class 46 points
  - d. 4th in class 44 points
  - e. 5th in class 42 points etc.
8. A retirement on an event will be awarded 6 points.
9. Where there is only one (1) championship competitor entered in a class, a handicap will apply of minus 3 points per event finished.
10. The Championship will be 5 rounds in total, with best 4 scores to count for the overall championship.
11. In the event of any events not running the following will apply;
  - a. 5 rounds 4 to score
  - b. 4 rounds 3 to score
  - c. 3 rounds 2 to score
  - d. 2 rounds or less all to score
12. Awards for the overall championship will be as follows:
  - a. 1st/2nd/3rd Overall Driver/Co-Driver
  - b. 1st/2nd/3rd in each Class Driver/Co-Driver (depending on no. of entries)
  - c. Highest Placed Lady Driver
  - d. Highest Placed Lady Co-Driver
  - e. Under 25 Driver or Co-Driver (must make known at time of registration)

13. To receive an award a competitor must have scored a finish.
14. No competitor may win more than one award other than a Ladies award, Under 25 in the Championship. In the event of a tie, the competitor scoring the highest number of first places taken the higher placing; then scoring the highest number of second places and so on until the tie is resolved. 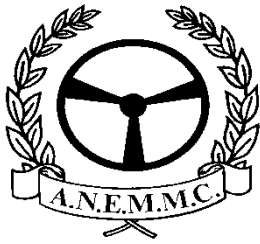

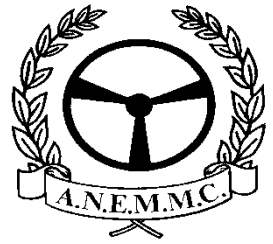
