#### b. Treasurer.

#### c. Stage Rally Co-ordinator.

With the Championship rounds now finalised the registration have been distributed.

The Multi-venue has seen the Riponian Stages as the first round and it is hope that this will take the ANEMMC Championship to some more northern contenders.

There are 7 rounds in total with the best 5 to count and the events are split between the Yorkshire and Notts Forests.

Multi-use Championship starts with Cadwell Park stages on February 28<sup>th</sup> and with the addition of one rally at Wilbaston in June and Armstrong Massey at Melbourne in July the selection of events is even better than previous years.
