ROUND 7 - THE MERCIAN RALLY – 25th-26th September 2010

ORGANISING CLUB – Mercia MC

36 crews started the Mercian Rally consisting of 8 ANEMMC navigators and 5 ANEMMC drivers. Guy Robinson/Charlie Wheeldon were seeded car 1, Stuart Caine was driving car 3, Sasha Heriot was navigating in car 6, David Bell navigating in car 7. Top seeded ANEMMC Novices were Jon Hill/Michael Pears in car 26.

Timecard 1 was cleaned by all crews, timecard 2 saw Guy Robinson/Charlie Wheeldon fastest on ITCA on 1m18s. 6th= were Sasha Heriot and Chris & Trevor Faulkner on 2m13s closely followed by Richard French 8th on 2m14s. David Bell was 13th on 3m8s, 14th= was Bethan Blythe on 3m12s with leading ANEMMC Novices Jon Hill/Michael Pears 16th on 3m24s. Sasha Heriot was fastest on ITCB on 1m21s with David Bell 5th on 1m52s. Stuart Caine was 14th on 2m13s with Jon Hill/Michael Pears fastest ANEMMC Novices 21st= on 3m, they were to lose a total of 9m on the following sections before retiring from the event. Richard French missed STC17 and suffered a heavy penalty. Sasha Heriot was the leading ANEMMC competitor at the end of timecard 2, 2nd on 3m58s with Guy Robinson/Charlie Wheeldon 3rd on 3m56s. Chris & Trevor Faulkner were 7th on 4m33s, David Bell was 9th on 5m, Bethan Blythe was 11th on 5m31s and 13th was Stuart Caine on 6m16s.

Timecard 3 was cleaned by most crews, then timecard 4, ITCC Stuart Caine was fastest on 46s, followed by Guy Robinson/Charlie Wheeldon 2nd= on 1m9s, 5th was David Bell on 1m29s, Richard French was 11th on 2m13s, Bethan Blythe was 12th on 2m16s.

Guy Robinson/Charlie Wheeldon were 2nd overall on 5m5s with Sasha Heriot 5th on 6m10s, David Bell 6th on 6m29s, Stuart Caine 7th on 7m2s, the heavy penalties on timecard 2 pushing him back and Bethan Blythe rounding off the top 10 on 7m47s.

ROUND 8 - THE JACKSON TROPHY RALLY – 9th-10th October 2010

ORGANISING CLUB – Sheffield & Hallamshire MC

37 crews started the Jackson Trophy Rally consisting of 7 ANEMMC Navigators and 7 ANEMMC Drivers.

Ade Green/Ian Gibbins were the top seeded ANEMMC crew in car 5 with Hugh Garnish/David Bell 14th. Chris Faulkner was seeded top Semi-Expert 17th, Rhiannon Wilkinson 18th, Bethan Blythe 21st, Andy Stewart/Roger Stoneley 22nd, Richard French 23rd, John Hill/Michael Pears 27th and Bob Ward/Karl Ellis the leading ANEMMC Novices in car 31.

I don't have a detailed breakdown of the results but after timecard 1 Ade Green/Ian Gibbins were 5th on 1m34s, Hugh Garnish/David Bell were 8th on 2m20s, Chris Faulkner was the leading ANEMMC Semi-Expert 11th on 2m50s with Rhiannon Wilkinson 12th= on 3m, Bethan Blythe 14th on 3m6s. Andy Stewart/Roger Stoneley were 15th on 5m5s and Bob Ward/Karl Ellis 22nd on 14m51s.

At the end of timecard 2, Ade Green/Ian Gibbins were 6th fastest on 5m44s with Hugh Garnish/David Bell 7th on 5m57s. Bethan Blythe was 12th on 6m46s, Chris Faulkner 16th on 9m27s, Andy Stewart/Roger Stoneley 17th on 10m50s, Rhiannon Wilkinson 18th on 11m1s and Bob Ward/Karl Ellis 24th on 21m48s.

The highest places ANEMMC competitors were Ade Green/Ian Gibbins 4th overall on 7m18s, Hugh Garnish/David Bell were 8th on 8m7s, Bethan Blythe was 1st Semi-Expert, 11th on 9m52s, Chris Faulkner was 13th on 12m17s, Rhiannon Wilkinson was 14th on 14m1s, Andy Stewart/Roger Stoneley were 17th on 15m55s and Bob Ward/Karl Ellis were 1st Novices 22nd overall on 36m39s

Looking at the tables Sasha Heriot's leading the Navigators championship, closely followed by David Bell, both having 6 scores to count with Bethan Blythe 3rd a few points behind with one score dropped. It should be noted that both David and Bethan have 5 scores over 25 points, one more high score will mean they're not eligible for the Novice awards. Charlie Wheeldon in 4th place has 4 full scores plus his marshalling points, another win would give Charlie the title on a maximum score.

Chris Faulkner's leading the Drivers championship, one point ahead of Ade Green. Chris having one dropped score from 7 and Ade a near perfect score with one non-finish on the Drystone with 2 more rounds to go, if Ade marshals on one of the next rounds then the

championship's his again. Hugh Garnish is 3rd with Steve Johnson close behind in 4th both with 5 scores to count. Hugh has 4 scores above 25 so allowing one more score for the Novice awards.

If any of the above win the top 3 places then the Novice awards will be cascaded downwards.

I've not been advised that anyone's marshaled on the last two rounds so the championship tables may alter slightly.
