

ANEMMC ROAD RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP 2008

ORGANISERS REGULATIONS

1. All fully paid up affiliated Motor Clubs within the ANEMMC may submit events for inclusion within this Championship. All events must be National B events.
2. All events will run to the General Competition Rules of the MSA and must be open to all Member Clubs of the ANEMMC or Registered Contenders of the ANEMMC Road Rally Championship.
3. The Association levy will be payable upon acceptance into the Championship and is to be sent to the Association Treasurer no later than the 31st January in the year of the Championship. Should an event fail to run, the levy will be refunded in full to the respective Motor Club.
4. The MSA Waiver of Permit Number.....has been issued for the ANEMMC Road Rally Championship. A copy of the appropriate permit will be forwarded to all event organisers. Please ensure that the permit number is published within the event Supplementary regulations and is displayed on the Official Notice Board throughout the running of the event.
5. Organisers are to ensure that they keep the Co-ordinator fully consulted at all times with regard to any date changes, problems with the event or other such details.
6. Regulations **MUST** clearly state that the event is a round of the ANEMMC Road Rally Championship and **MUST** carry a full page advertisement of any Championship sponsor(s). The artwork will be provided by the Co-ordinator. Organisers are to ensure that two sets of Regulations are forwarded to the Co-ordinator at the time of publication and further paperwork such as Final Instructions, Full Final Entry List (including individual Clubs, whether ANEMMC Contenders and Class entered), and a Final set of Results are sent as soon as possible. Organisers must send event Regulations to all Registered Contenders. The Co-ordinator will provide labels for this purpose. Failure to comply with these requests may result in the event not being selected for the Championship the following year.
7. Event Organisers must ensure that sufficient space is made available at signing on for the Championship Tables to be displayed and Signing-On Sheets for the Association Contenders to complete. These Sheets will be provided by the Co-ordinator prior to the event.
8. Event Organisers must ensure that all Contender Registration Cards are shown at Signing-On.
9. Promotional material may be passed to the Co-ordinator for publication within the Association Championship Bulletin and on the Association Website.

ANEMMC ROAD RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP 2008

COMPETITOR REGULATIONS

1. The Championship will be known as the ANEMMC Road Rally Championship.
2. Qualifying events have been chosen by the Road Rally Co-ordinator from events that have been submitted from member clubs in accordance with the current 'Dates' procedures. If through Force Majeure any of the qualifying event dates are altered or any event is cancelled, the Association reserves the right to accept date changes, cancel that particular round as qualifying, substitute the event or alter the number of events to count. No additional events will be added to the Championship. All Championship Contenders will be notified in advance of any changes.
3. All fully paid up members of member clubs, who have registered for the ANEMMC Road Rally Championship **MUST** have paid the appropriate Registration Fee, may score points. Registration **MUST** have been made in advance of the first event that points are to be claimed for.
4. The ANEMMC Road Rally Championship will consist of five classes:-
 - a. Overall Championship – Drivers and Navigators
 - b. Novice Championship – Drivers and Navigators
 - c. Under 21yrs (also to be included with the above)
 - d. Ladies Championship (also to be included in 1, 2 & 3)

To be eligible for the Under 21yrs Class, the date of birth is taken as at the date of Registration and the contender remains within that class for the remainder of the Championship year.

5. Points will be awarded in the Championship on the basis of OVERALL results, irrespective of Class entered for the particular event, scored on the following basis:-
 - a. 1st Registered ANEMMC Driver/Navigator – 30 Points
 - b. 2nd Registered ANEMMC Driver/Navigator – 29 Points
 - c. 3rd Registered ANEMMC Driver/Navigator – 28 Points
 - d. And so on down to the last Registered ANEMMC finisher
 - e. All contenders who start but do not qualify for the above score 1 point

A NOVICE Class shall run in tandem to the overall Championship and scoring system. A NOVICE is defined as a competitor who has not won a National B Road Rally or has NOT scored 25 points or more on an individual ANEMMC Road Rally Championship round on three or more occasions, excluding the maximum 30 Point score for marshalling.

The Under 21yrs Class and the Ladies Class will run in tandem with the overall Championship and scoring system; that is, whatever points are scored for the overall Championship, the same points are allocated towards the Under 21yrs & Ladies Class.

6. The onus rests with the contenders to obtain event regulations. However, the event organisers will be supplied with the current registered name and address labels to enable them to forward sets of regulations to you.
7. It is MANDATORY that the Championship decals are displayed at ALL times during an event on the competing car, if either of the crew are contenders.
8. It is not necessary for Drivers and Navigators to be the same partnership for all events throughout the year, as the scoring system is calculated on an individual basis every event.

9. The number of Rounds to count will be as follows:-
 - a. 12 Rounds or more run Best 8 to count
 - b. 11 Rounds run Best 7 to count
 - c. 10 or 9 Rounds run Best 6 to count
 - d. 8 to 6 Rounds run Best 5 to count
 - e. 5 Rounds run or less All to count

10. Awards will be presented as follows:-
 - a. 1st Overall Driver and Navigator
 - b. 2nd Overall Driver and Navigator
 - c. 3rd Overall Driver and Navigator
 - d. 1st Novice Driver and Navigator
 - e. 2nd Novice Driver and Navigator
 - f. 3rd Novice Driver and Navigator
 - g. 1st Under 21yrs Driver and Navigator
 - h. 1st Lady Driver and Navigator

In the event of a tie at the end of the Championship, the following will be used to determine a clear result:-

- 1 – Greatest number of maximum 30 point scores
 - 2 – Greatest number of 29 point scores....etc...until the tie is resolved
- Only ONE award may be won by an individual other than the Under 21yrs or Lady awards.

11. Entrants must indicate on their entry form that they are an ANEMMC Road Rally Championship Contender. Acceptance of entries will be at the discretion of individual event organisers and the ANEMMC Association cannot be held responsible for refusal of any entry.

12. In order to score points from each event, the contenders **MUST** sign-on upon the official ANEMMC Road Rally Championship sheet at the start. Clearly state your name, start number, whether Under 21yrs Class/Ladies Class and your personal ANEMMC registration number. Registration Cards may be requested for inspection at the start of each event.

13. Competitors who MARSHAL or OFFICIATE on any **ONE** ANEMMC Road Rally Championship event, will be eligible for a once only score of **30** points (same as a MAXIMUM score). This requirement is NOT mandatory, however it is the same as being 1st place ANEMMC contender, thus rewarding. It is the competitors responsibility to provide evidence of the marshalling/officiating duty completed. Competitors contending both Drivers and Navigators categories may claim on two occasions, one for each category.
