### Competitors Regulations

1. The Championship will be known as "The ROADRUNNER PHOENIX AWARDS ANEMMC Multi-use Stage Rally Championship 2008"
  2. Events to be included in the championship have been selected from events nominated by member clubs and approved at an Association meeting. These events have been observed and approved for inclusion in the Championship.
  3. All fully paid up members or member clubs who have registered as contenders as a Driver or Co-driver and who have paid the registration fee shall be eligible to compete. Registration must have been made and accepted before any event for which points can be scored.
  4. The Championship will be divided into 5 classes as follows:
    - Class 1 ~ up to 1400cc
    - Class 2 ~ 1401cc to 1600cc
    - Class 3 ~ 1601cc to 2000cc
    - Class 4 ~ over 2000cc
    - Class 5 ~ all 4 wheel drive cars only
- Cars which have forced induction will have their engine capacity increased by 70% to determine their class eligibility in accordance with MSA regulations.
5. Points will be awarded in the Championship with reference to class positions in the official results and relative to his/her performance against other registered

contenders. Points can only be awarded to contenders on NAT B Stage Rallies where an event may be a round of a National series.

Points will be awarded as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> in class	50 points
2 <sup>nd</sup> in class	47 points
3 <sup>rd</sup> in class	44 points
4 <sup>th</sup> in class	41 points
5 <sup>th</sup> in class	38 points etc.

A retirement on an event will be awarded 6 points.

Points will only be awarded to contenders on NAT B Stage Rallies.

Where there is only ONE championship competitor entered in a class a handicap will apply of minus 5 points per event finished.

*The Championship will be 12 rounds in total, with best 8 scores to count for the overall championship.*

*In the event of any events not running the following will apply:*

*12 rounds 8 to score*

*11 rounds 8 to score*

*10 rounds 7 to score*

*9 rounds 6 to score*

*8 rounds 5 to score*

**5 or less all to count**

Awards for the overall championship will be as follows:

1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> Overall Driver/Co-Driver

1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> in each Class Driver/Co-Driver (depending on no. of entries)

Highest Placed Lady Driver

Highest Placed Lady Co-Driver

Under 25 Driver or Co-Driver (must make known at time of registration)

To receive an award a competitor must have scored a finish.

No competitor may win more than one award other than a Ladies award, Under 25 in the Championship. In the event of a tie, the competitor scoring the highest

number of first places taken the higher placing; then scoring the highest number of second places and so on until the tie is resolved. In the event of a double tie we will take highest score on the first event competed on.

6. It is the competitor's responsibility to obtain event regulations.
7. Acceptance of all entries will be at each organiser's discretion and ANEMMC cannot be held responsible for any refusal of entries.
8. Entrants must indicate their registration number on their event entry forms.
9. Once a competitor has paid their registration fee and returned the registration form points shall automatically be collated from events results without further signing-on at each event. Registration cards may be required at signing-on at the discretion of each individual event organisers.
10. It is not necessary for Drivers and Co-drivers to be in the same crew for all events, during the year, as results will be kept for each category.
11. Registered contenders will be supplied with two Championship decals, which must be displayed on the competing car at all events.
